two stars above it and five navy blue service stripes or hash marks. There is an interior label that reads “Seagoing Uniform Corp. // skipper ® // summer uniform // fabric is sanforized” sewn in blue and red. Most likely worn with 2017.43.02 and 2017.43.03.
