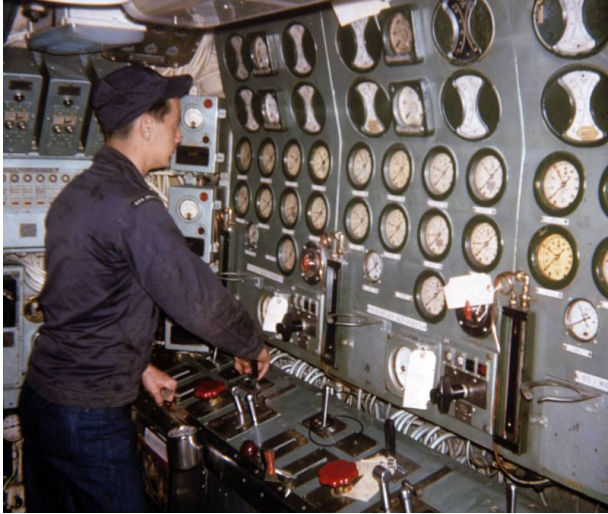

Many gauges and indicators are on the wall. Romeyn Latham is standing with his hands on the control sticks for the no. 3 generator set. He is wearing a blue cap, blue dungarees and a blue jacket with U.S.S. Growler on the right shoulder. He has light skin and dark hair. Visible at left, behind Latham, is a hull openings indicator panel. Decommissioning tags on some of the equipment suggest a photo date of 1964. Slide mount has "Made in U.S.A." printed in black and "21" written in black ink on one side. "Kodachrome // duplicate // made by Kodak" printed in black on the other side.
