

Extent: 2 folders The John F. Forsyth Papers include papers from the aircraft carrier USS Intrepid (CV-11) and the U.S. Navy during Forsyth's service during World War II. Forsyth served aboard Intrepid in 1944 as a SB2C Helldiver pilot with Bombing Squadron 18 (VB-18). Included in this collection are a training manual on flight quarters, recognition magazines, an issue of Intrepid's
