SCHEDULE OF SHIP'S ROUTINE TO BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH NAVAIRLANT/NAVAFAC CV SHIP INSTRU-
TION 5330.1 EXCEPT FOR THE FOLLOWING CHANGES AND ADDITIONS:
0600 - Reveille.
0800 - Muster on Stations. Departments submit muster reports prior to 0830.
1600 - Lay before the Mast all the night o'clock reports.
1900 - Band concert on the flight deck.

1. Last night a WAVE mermaid messenger hailed the ship and informed the Captain that Davy Jones, the Royal Scribe, accompanied by a party of Royal Personages, will come aboard the USS SHIP INTREPID on Monday, 17 June 1968, to deliver a communication from NEPTUNE REX, whose domain the ship will soon be entering.

2. The Royal Scribe will come aboard officially; that is, as a Personal Ambassador Extraordinary and Minister Plenipotentiary of his Majesty, NEPTUNE REX, Ruler of the Aging Main and Mystic Deep, and also Grand Mongol of the Far East.

3. All hands must realize that this official visit will be a most solemn occasion. Everyone is enjoined to help ensure that the good name of the GOLD SHIP INTREPID is not besmirched.

4. The Royal Scribe and his party are expected at about 1615; however, the exact time of arrival, the means by which they will travel is not known. They may come by plane, ship, submarine, amphibious jeep, Dolphin Chariot, or Sea Horse Punt. To this end, that the approach of the party will be duly detected and final arrangements will be made on time, Special Squator Details will be set at 1500. Other times and events are to be as follows:
1500 - All Pollywogs stand by for inspection in Pollywog Inspection Uniform.
1515 - Call away Pollywog Guard of the Day. Pollywog Guard of the Day muster port side of Island. Pollywog SUT HALL to take charge.
1520 - Pollywog Choir and Band report to Special OOD (ENS HANNS) port nine of Island.
1530 - Special Pollywog Medical Squad report to Flight Deck abreast of island to treat anyone overcome by listening to vocals and music.
1540 - Pollywog Band render South Sea Music for Hula Dance. Hula Dance by CR and CS divisions.
1545 - Commence bucket brigade in Mangar Bay T&C.
1600 - (About) Prepare to receive Davy Jones aboard. All Special Squator Watches keep a sharp lookout. When sighted, regular OOD sound attention. To be followed by five short blasts over all circuits.
1615 - (About) Davy Jones hails the ship. Reception of Davy Jones and his Party.
1645 - Davy Jones departs.
