Description

Photograph, Black and white; Official vertical image of a photographer's mate in dungarees holding several cameras and other pieces of photography equipment. He is standing in the photo lab. There is a doorway behind him. He is holding one camera up to his eye and looking at the camera through it. He has dark hair and medium-

dark skin. There is a white border around the image. The donor identified the cameras and equipment as follows: The black camera under the man's arm is a K-25 aerial camera. The camera near his face is a Graflex Super Graphic 4x5. The camera around his neck is a Nikon 35mm. The light meter hanging near the Nikon camera is a Weston Master V light meter. The light meter hanging near the K-25 is a Luminex 3 light meter. The flash hanging near the black camera case is a Honeywell electronic flash. Back has the outline of a square drawn in black ink.
