Graffiti includes "Fly 3", "VA-145", "VA-34", "ADJ-3", "HC-2 Det", "Mar-Det // V-1 Div.", and the blue blaster's logo is on the side. A crew member in a green jersey is walking next to the plane. The water off the ship is calm. There are small black discolorations throughout the image and two fingerprint smudges in the upper left.
